Policy on Managing Aggressive Behaviour from Parents and Visitors

Introduction

A parent (or guardian) is a key stakeholder in the learning process of a child. Parental involvement is an important factor in educational success and in dealing with emerging problems at an early stage. MEC Institutions believe that pupils benefit when the relationship between home and school is a positive one. If a parent is unhappy or dissatisfied with some aspect, the school encourages grievance redressal through dialogue. This way there is scope for improvement and corrective measures to be taken. However, on the rare occasions when a negative attitude towards the institution is expressed by a parent or guardian, this can result in aggression, verbal and or physical abuse towards members of the staff, pupils, or other members of the institution.



All members of MEC Institutions have a right to work and learn in a safe place. Since majority of MEC staff are women, violence, threatening behaviour and abuse against school staff or other members of the school community will not be tolerated. There is no place for violence, threatening behaviour or abuse in an institution. Where such behaviour does occur, management will be forced to initiate action to deal with it.

MEC Institutions explicitly mention the desirable behaviour of parents on campus. However, in the unlikely event of aggressive or abusive parents and visitors who cause nuisance, this document provides guidance for dealing with the same.

A parent (guardian) of a student of MEC Institutions, normally has implied permission to be on the institution premises at certain times and for certain purposes. We expect parents and other visitors to behave in a reasonable way towards members of school staff. This policy outlines the steps that will be taken where behaviour is unacceptable.

Unacceptable Behaviour

Types of behaviour that are considered serious and unacceptable and will not be tolerated:

- Shouting at members of the school staff, either in person or over the telephone
- Physically intimidating a member of staff
- Use of aggressive gestures
- Threatening behaviour
- Swearing
- Pushing
- Spitting
- Breaching the school's security procedures

This is not an exhaustive list but seeks to provide illustrations of such behaviour.

Measures Taken

If situations go beyond control, suitable action will be taken. This can include:

- Initiate a meeting/dialogue with the individual
- Write to the parent/ visitor, describing their misconduct, explaining its impact on the school and stating its unacceptability
- Warn of the possibility of a "ban" if the misconduct is repeated
- Impose a ban with a review after a fixed period
- Impose a ban without review.

Parental Rights

Every attempt will be made to maintain normal communications with parents (guardians). Even where a parent has been banned from the school premises, they retain their right to an annual consultation in relation to the educational progress of their children.

The interests of the child continue to be paramount.

A Message To The Parent

Dear Parent,

- The diary is a link between the teacher and the parent. It keeps parents informed about their ward's progress, his/her strengths and weaknesses.
- Students must bring the diary to school everyday. Rules and regulations mentioned in the diary are framed keeping in mind the general requirements and morals of the institution. Hence, co-operate with the school authorities in observing these rules and regulations.
- In order to secure all that is best in the education for your ward, the maximum co-operation between you and the school is necessary. You are required to look into your ward's school diary everyday and see to it that the home work assigned for the next day is completed. Remarks made in the diary should be seen and countersigned regularly.
- Details about the year's events, test and examination schedule, holidays & instructions are given separately in a printed booklet. Parents are requested to check the calendar of events booklet regularly and encourage their wards to participate in each and every activity.
- Parents are requested to see that the pupil actively participates in the sports and co-curricular activities held during the academic year. This helps the pupil to exhibit his/her talent without fear. All cannot be winners but participation is more important than winning a prize.
- Parent-teacher meetings are arranged to enable the parents to meet the teachers to know the day-to-day progress of the wards and the problems faced by them in their studies. One should seek counselling from the teachers in serious matters faced by the wards. Parents not caring for the advice from the concerned teachers and the principal, will take sole responsibility for their ward's academic excellence.
- Therefore, we earnestly request the parents to look into their ward's school diary everyday and see that their wards regularly prepare their lessons and do their home assignments. Students should be encouraged to cultivate good study habits, neatness and regularity in their work.
- If parents feel that the progress of their ward is not up to the mark, they are requested to contact the principal at the earliest for the remedial actions. Private tuition is discouraged. Criticism of the school or teachers in the presence of the pupil should be avoided because it makes them lose respect for the teachers and give room for indiscipline.
- If pupil contacts infectious diseases like measles, chicken pox etc. he/she should remain at home for treatment and can attend the school after complete recovery as per doctor's advice, in order to prevent the spread of the diseases.

Parental Co-operation

1. All the students are required to enter the school campus before morning prayer, i.e., 10 minutes earlier for the assembly and prayer.
2. While escorting your ward to and from the school, do not follow the pupil to the classroom. Leave the pupil at the gate in the quadrangle under our care.
3. The school premises have to be kept free for morning prayer, assembly and physical education programs. Hence, avoid crowding the place.
4. As far as possible, avoid calling back your ward during the class hours.
5. Pupil should avoid carrying sharp instruments and electronic gadgets like FM radio, camera, mobiles, etc. to school.
6. If the pupil is left in the school premises beyond 15 minutes after the final bell, the institution cannot take responsibility for the pupil. Hence, be on time to pick up your ward back home.
7. The school is not to be held responsible for any incidence after the school hours outside the school premises.
8. Parents should meet the class teacher only after 3.40 pm.
9. Parents can meet the principal with prior appointment only. Parents should strictly adhere to the timings.
